

Elective Credits

Students in the MA in Youth Ministry program can utilize their elective credits to tailor a program to their specific ministry needs. Students may select courses approved for academic graduate degrees from any of the Andrews University schools, provided there is a correlation with the chosen field of youth ministry. They can take up to 6 credits in CHMN690 Independent Study.

Field Practicum

Students must take 6 credits in CHMN660 Field Practicum. Normally registration is allowed only after the student has earned 24 or more credits.

Credits in Learning Experience

In place of CHMN660 Field Practicum, some students may be eligible for up to 6 credits, as approved by the dean, for Learning in Professional Experience based on the criteria listed under the MA in Pastoral Ministry program, p. 340.

Thesis Option

As an elective option, students may choose to write a Master of Arts thesis (GSEM697) for a total of 6 credits. Under this option, the thesis De in (Ostuden340).

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In the event that a required course is not offered during any given term, another course in the same area can be substituted for the
